

Martin Warriors vs. Bowie Volunteers

Game Summary:

The Martin Warriors began district play by hosting the Bowie Volunteers at Warrior Field. Martin put the game out of reach early with a big first inning and finished with a 12 – 2 victory.

Lefty Brandon Turner started on the hill for the Warriors and pitched a complete game. In five innings of work, Turner gave up 2 runs on two hits while striking out three Volunteer batters. No Volunteer base runners made it past second base after the first inning.

The big hit of the game came early as Conner Gamblin stroked a 3 RBI double to leftfield in the first inning. Tim Brewer and Jacob Shannon were also catalyst for the offense collecting 2 hits and 2 RBI each. Matt Hendrix (1 hit, 1 RBI, and 3 runs scored), Trenton Buchhorn (3 RBI and 1 run scored), and Danny Flores (3 runs scored) rounded out the Warrior attack.
