

## Martin Warriors vs. Summit Jaguars

### Game Summary:

In the final game of the freshman season, the Warriors beat up the Summit Jaguars 7-2. Blake Egly, returning from a 2 month stint on the disabled list, started on the mound for Martin and threw four strong innings. For his efforts, Egly got the win while giving up only 5 hits with 1 strikeout and walks. Blake Johnson pitched the last two innings giving up no runs on no hits while striking out 3 and giving up 3 walks.

The Warrior bats were hot from the start and stayed that way. Martin scored in every inning except the third. Collin Lawrence singled in the first inning and scored on Ricky Swink's long single to right-centerfield. The second inning started with Carson Johnson's single followed by Blake Johnson's walk. An error on the Jaguar right fielder on Chris Chapin's hit and a single by Clint Crabtree brought in both Johnsons.

In the fourth inning, the Warriors rattled off four hits in five at-bats with Crabtree, Coleman Jensen, Lawrence, and Ross Erickson collecting hits. Three runs scored with Jensen, Swink, and Erickson ringing up RBI's. Blake Johnson started the fifth inning with a double, moved to third on a fielder's choice, and scored on an error by the Jag's third baseman.

Leading hitters for the freshmen were Clint Crabtree (3 hits, 1 RBI, and 1 run scored), Collin Lawrence (2 hits and 2 runs scored), and Ricky Swink (2 hits and 2 RBI).

Defensively, the Warriors turned 3 double plays to keep Jaguars runners from scoring.

The Martin freshman ended the 2009 season with a final record of 15 wins and 5 losses and a final district record of 8 wins and 3 losses.
