

Martin vs. Bowie

Game Summary

In the JV Warriors first district game of the 2009 season against the Bowie Volunteers, Nick Hendrix was on the hill as the starting pitcher at the Diamonds at Martin. He threw 3 innings, faced 11 batters with 5 K's, and 1 hit with no runs. His first inning was 3 up/3 down. The Warriors started their offensive run with a single from Mitchell Peck. Nathan Gourley had walked so there were 2 on when Collin Day stroked a double for 2 RBI's. Alex Bradley drew a walk but the 3rd out left 2 stranded. The top of the 2nd had 2 Bowie runners put on base by Warrior errors. Hendrix had 2 K's and a ground out to pitcher making all 3 defensive plays to shut down the Vol threat. The bottom of the 2nd scored 2 runs again for the JV Warriors. It started with Matt Kazmierski hitting a single up the middle then stealing his way around to 3rd to set himself up to score. Gourley drew yet another walk putting 2 on base. Peck then knocked a double scoring Kazmierski and Gourley's pinch runner, Brady Harvey. Top of the 3rd Bowie got their first hit, a single and the runner who had advanced to 2nd on a stolen base was picked off at 2nd. In the bottom of the 3rd, Bradley ripped a triple and came home on a wild pitch. Daniel Chamberlain drew a walk and was advanced by a single by Travis Barkhurst. Both runners were left stranded. Seth Henry came in to pitch the next 3 innings. He faced 14 batters, with 7 K's, 2 walks and gave up 2 hits. Top and Bottom of the 4th were scoreless for both teams. In the 5th the first batter, Aaron Warren was hit by a pitch and Lance Mardock got on base by an error by the Bowie 2nd baseman. Harvey then hit a single to score both runners and was left stranded. In the top of the 6th Bowie scored their lone run after a runner had reached on error by the Warrior shortstop. The next batter bunted for a hit to score him. In the bottom of the 6th, Alec Shurack got the scoring started by hitting a single and stealing his way to 2nd. Henry then forced the Bowie 1st baseman to make an error and reached base. With runners now on 2nd and 3rd, Warren hit a double scoring both runners. Mike Hoffman hit a single with Brady Harvey following up with a triple for 2 RBI's to end the game for the JV Warriors 1st district win of the 2009 season.
