

# Martin vs. LD Bell

## Game Summary

In the JV's 1st non-district game of the 2009 season, Aaron Warren was on the hill for the Warriors. Bottom of 2 LD Bell again started out with a hit and the runner stole his way around to 3<sup>rd</sup>, scoring on a wild pitch. Top of 3 the Warriors produced no runs or hits. In the bottom of the 3<sup>rd</sup>, a dropped 3<sup>rd</sup> strike put the runner on 1<sup>st</sup>. Stealing his way around, he scored on a pass ball by the catcher, Gourley. An error by Travis Barkhurst at 2<sup>nd</sup> put the next LD Bell runner on followed by a 2<sup>nd</sup> error by Barkhurst which allowed another unearned run to score. Top of 4 and 5 were uneventful for both teams. The Warriors made one last attempt to come back but fell short. Hendrix hit another single and was able to score on a sac fly to right field by Collin Day.
