

Martin vs. Lamar

Game Summary

The JV Warriors were home at the Diamonds at Martin for their 1st district matchup of the season with the Lamar Vikings. Collin Day was on the mound for the Warriors pitching 2 and 2/3 innings. The Vikings struck first on the 2nd pitch of the game when their leadoff batter hit a homerun. It was then another quick 2 outs and time for the Warriors to play defense. Unfortunately, the Warriors committed 2 more errors and when combined with 6 Viking singles, this allowed the Vikings to get 7 runs in top of the 3rd. Hendrix came in to pitch in this inning with 2 outs on the Vikings. The bottom of the 3rd yielded no runs for the Warriors although we had 2 on from a Day single and an error on the Viking 3rd baseman. In the top of the 4th, it was a 3 up/ 3 down inning with 3 K's for Hendrix. In the bottom of the 4th, Aaron Warren reached on an error by Lamar's 1st baseman. Bradley then stroked a double, which put runners on 2nd and 3rd. Bradley was doubled up on a fly ball. Mitchell Peck then hit an RBI single scoring Warren. Hendrix then singled with Day being hit by pitch. Unfortunately, the Warriors were unable to make the best of a bases loaded situation and didn't score any more runs, with the Warriors leaving a total of 7 base runners on so far in the game. Top of the 5th was another Viking 3 up/ 3 down with 2 more K's for Hendrix. Bottom of the 5th was just as uneventful for the Warriors with 3 up/ 3 down. Top of 6 was had no Viking offense. In the bottom of the 6th, Bradley led off the inning with a homerun shot over the left center field fence. Shurack then followed with a single but was unable to score as the next 3 batters were put out. In the top of the 7th, the Vikings piled on 3 more runs with 3 hits and yet another Warrior defensive error. The score was now 14-5, with a loss for the Warriors looming. In the bottom of the 7th, the JV Warriors decided the game was far from over..... Gourley and Barkhurst were both hit by pitches. Brady Harvey then hit a fielders choice, reaching 1st but Barkhurst was put out at 2nd. Gourley was sitting on 3rd. Mike Hoffman then hit another fielders choice, reaching 1st but Harvey was put out at 2nd. Bradley then reached on a walk. 3 Warrior runners were now on base. Shurack then ripped a 3 RBI double to score the 3 runners. Peck reached on a walk, giving the Warriors 2 more base runners. Hendrix then singled, scoring Shurack. 2 base runners...wanting to come home. Day was then hit by a pitch, and now there were 3. The Warriors had batted around and Gourley and Barkhurst both hit RBI singles to score 2 more Warrior runs. The bases were still juiced. Harvey was up and smashed a triple, scoring 3 more Warrior runs. If you've lost count, the game is now tied with Harvey waiting at 3rd to come home. Hoffman then came up to hit an RBI single to score Harvey for the winning run! All this with 2 outs. Great comeback Warriors!
