

Martin vs. Mansfield

Game Summary

In the JV Warriors 1st district game with the Mansfield Tigers at the Diamonds, it was another windy night. Jerid Watson was on the hill for the Warriors throwing 4 innings, with 1 K, 2 BB's, giving up 7 hits and 5 earned runs. In the top of the 1st the Tigers were shut down with no runs. Bottom of the 2nd the Warriors struck first after Mitchell Peck was walked and then scored on Collin Day's RBI double. The top of the 2nd was not the Warriors best inning as it had the Tigers scoring all of their 5 runs in this inning on 5 strategic hits. In the bottom of the 2nd the Warriors failed to capitalize on 3 walks by the Mansfield pitcher and left all 3 stranded on base. In the top of the 3rd, despite the only Warrior error of the game, the Tiger offense was silenced. In the bottom of the 3rd the only Warrior run came on a walk by Nick Hendrix who managed to make his way around the bases, scoring on a wild pitch. In the top of the 4th the Tigers were unable to score and left one runner stranded after he was hit by a pitch. In the bottom of the 4th the Warriors were unable to get any runners across the plate despite singles by Brady Harvey, Mike Hoffman and Peck. In the top of the 5th Alex Bradley came in to pitch for the Warriors. The Tiger offense was shut down with a 3 up/ 3 down half inning. The Warriors had a 2 run bottom of the 5th. Nathan Gourley walked and his pinch runner, Emilio Vialpando was RBI'd in on a double hit by Travis Barkhurst. Bradley then walked and Harvey knocked a single advancing him and Barkhurst, to load the bases. 1 strikeout later Alec Shurack then hit a single to score Barkhurst. The bases were again loaded but the Warriors failed to put any more runs across the plate stranding a total of 9 Warrior runners so far for the night. Top of the 6th despite a lead off walk, the Tigers couldn't get a run across the plate. Bottom of the 6th was 3 up/ 3 down for the Warriors with Day hitting a single and was thrown out trying to steal 2nd. The top of the 7th was also scoreless for the Tigers. In the bottom of the 7th, the Warriors were able to get 2 runners on with only 1 out, by a walk and an error on the Tiger SS. However, they were unable to get the runners advanced, leaving a total of 11 Warriors stranded on the bases for the night.
