

Martin vs. Summit

Game Summary

The JV Warriors were at the Summit Jaguars home field for a Friday night District matchup. Lance Mardock was on the mound for the Warriors. He threw 4 1/3 innings, faced 23 batters, had 1K, 3 BB's, 6 hits and gave up 4 runs. The top of the 1st started with Alec Shurack hitting a hard shot to the shortstop causing an error. Shurack stole around to third and was knocked in on an RBI single by Alex Bradley. Mardock shut down the Jaguars in the bottom of the 1st. In the top of the 2nd, Aaron Warren led off by reaching on an error by the 2nd baseman with Matt Kazmierski following up reaching on an error by Summit's 1st baseman. Daniel Chamberlain then knocked a single to get Warren in. Shurack hit a single, stole his way around and scored on a wild pitch. The 3rd and 4th innings were scoreless for both teams. In the top of the 5th, Bradley stroked a 2 out double, followed up by an RBI single by Mardock to score him. Josh Beckham then reached on an error by the 1st baseman which scored Mardock's pinch runner, Brady Harvey. In the bottom of the 5th the Jaguars' bats started to come alive as they scored 3 runs on 4 hits. Mike Hoffman came in to pitch with 1 out and successfully shut down the Jag's attempts to come back. In the top of the 6th the Warriors were unable to capitalize on a 2 out single by Shurack. Bottom of the 6th was scoreless for the Jags as Hoffman had 2 K's to squelch any offensive fire they may have had. In the top of the 7th, the bats came alive for the Warriors. The team scored 5 runs on doubles from Bradley, Collin Day, Harvey and Nathan Gourley. Hoffman contributed with an RBI single with Shurack pounding out a triple. In the bottom of the 7th Summit had 1 run on 2 hits to end a the game.
