Ryan Walker reaches on a fielder's choice, getting Hiller caught at home for an out. Walker steals 2nd and makes it on to third on another Arlington Colt error, putting Walker in scoring position. Chase Jensen hits to 2nd for an out and scoring Walker. Up next was Brian Ragira with a single, yet left stranded. Martin starts the 4th inning off with singles by Garcia, Thompson, and Tanner Hapeman, loading the bases. Hiller comes to the plate next with a double, scoring Garcia and Thompson, followed by a single from Walker, scoring Hapeman and Hiller. The Arlington Colts caught Martin three up, three down in the 5th. Martin scored two runs in the 6th inning from a walk by Trent Hunter who was batting for Thompson, a bunt by Hapeman, a single by Walker, and a double by Brian Ragira. With Rizzotti on the mound only one run was given up, 4 hits, 8 strikeouts, and no walks.
