

Martin vs. Sam Houston

Our first at bat against Same Houston was a good start and the bats never cooled from there. The first inning started the Warriors off with Ryan Walker reaching with a walk, a single by Chase Jensen, and Brian Ragira reaching by a Sam Houston error scoring Walker and Jensen. Ragira seals 2<sup>nd</sup>, reaches 3<sup>rd</sup> on a passed ball and scores on a wild pitch. Trevor Slocum reaches with a walk, steals 2<sup>nd</sup> on a passed ball, and takes 3<sup>rd</sup> on a wild pitch. Up next is Kyle Blackwell with a single, scording Slocum. Trey Thompson takes 1<sup>st</sup> on a walk but is left stranded. With four runs scored in the first inning, the Warriors continued to bust out the runs in the second inning. The first batter of the inning was Tanner Hapeman with a huge shot over the left centerfield fence for a homerun. Jensen reaches on an error and steals 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> on a wild pitch, putting him in scoring position. Up next was Ragira with a blast over the fence for another Warrior homerun, bringing Jensen in with him. Slocum reaches with a single while Garcia and Blackwell reach on walks, loading the bases. Slocum crosses the plate on a wild pitch, moving Garcia and Blackwell to 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>, only for Garcia to steal home moving Blackwell to 3<sup>rd</sup>. Thompson steps up to plate with the third over the fence homerun of the evening, scoring Blackwell with him. Hapeman is up again with a walk, followed with a walk from Hiller and a single by Walker, with a total of nine runs scored this inning. Slocum hits a single in the third. Keith Carney is in for Blackwell and hits the fourth homer of the night with a shot over the left field fence, bringing Slocum in with him. Jay Hiller starts the fourth inning off with a double, followed by a double from Russell Bellomy who is in for Jensen, which scores Hiller. Tyler Wilhelm took the mound the first two innings with five strikeouts and no walks. Stewart Person had the mound in the third and fourth innings with two strikeouts and no outs, and Dylan Rucker closed the game out in the fifth inning with three straight strikeouts.
