

Martin Warriors vs. Sam Houston

Game Summary:

The Warriors faced the Sam Houston Texans for a Friday night district matchup at the Diamonds at Martin. Collin Day was on the hill for the Warriors, throwing 6 innings and giving up 2 runs. Alex Bradley threw inning 7, giving up no runs or hits. The Texans jumped out on top of the Warriors in the 1st after a couple of singles. Despite a single from Mitchell Peck, the Warriors failed to score in the 1st. Sam Houston also got a run across in the second from another 2 hits. Martin answered back by getting a couple of runs across the plate benefitting from a single from Collin Lawrence a walk from Aaron Warren and another single from Drew Dowdy. Sam Houston was unable to score in the top of the 3rd despite another single. The Warriors were able to put a couple more runs on the board with a 2 out double from Nick Hendrix, followed by a few wild pitches and a walk from Nathan Gourley as well as an RBI single from Lawrence. Sam was unable to make anything from a single in the 4th. Martin added another 3 to their total in the 4th beginning when Warren reached on a strikeout error on the catcher followed by a sac bunt from Matt Waller to move him around. Drew Dowdy reached on a walk followed by an RBI single from Peck. Hendrix followed with another 2 bagger to score another run. The Texans were silenced in the top of the 5th as were the Warriors in the bottom of 5. The Texans got another hit in the 6th but couldn't get the runner across the plate. In the bottom of the 6th, Martin managed to capitalize on an error from Sam's outfield to score their final run of the game. Martin ended up on top, winning their 3rd of 3 district games this season.
